



Compatible Use

- Compatible use goes beyond land. It can include, but is not limited to, endangered species and critical habitat, unexploded ordnance and munitions, frequency spectrum, maritime, airspace management, air quality, airborne noise, dust, smoke, urban lighting, height of obstructions, and urban growth
- The primary area of concern is land use activity and civilian development that adversely affects the training and operational missions of a military installation
- The goal is to encourage cooperative planning between installations and surrounding communities resulting in a comprehensive strategic action plan designed to promote compatible community growth
